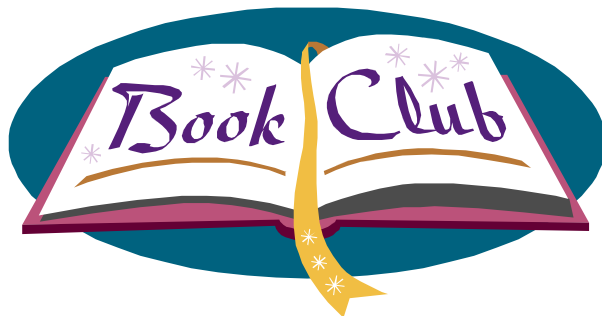


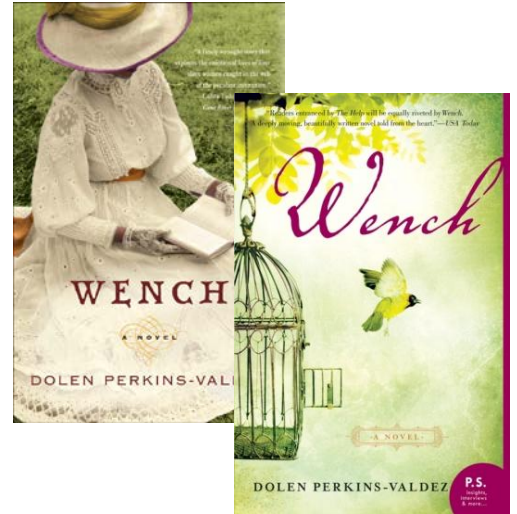

Eventually, their desire for freedom is sparked when they hear rumors of abolition and they are offered help by other free blacks.
